Increased Days for In-Person Learning

We are planning to have students in grade PreK through grade 4 back in the building all together, beginning October 5th on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. This of course is predicated on favorable health data. Wednesday will continue to be a deep cleaning day as well as a day for teacher planning and for the teaching of any remaining remote learners. If all goes well, students in grade 5 through grade 8 will be back all together in the building on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday on October 26th. Again, Wednesday will be a non-student day. The long range plan is to have all students back in the building five full days per week after Christmas. With that said, please realize that at a moment's notice, school could be cancelled for a specific amount of time if a COVID case occurs in the school. This could result in a classroom closure or a full school closure depending upon the situation. A call, email and text will alert parents if a temporary or more permanent closure occurs. Parents should have back-up plans for their children if these possible changes take place. However, we are looking forward to having everyone back as outlined and that life will resume in a more normal routine. Please be advised that the buses will continue to plan on picking up every child regardless if the student is returning to LCS. Please let the office know if your child is not attending; otherwise the Attendance Secretary will make a call home. Thank you for your cooperation.
