Meals

Reminder: If you have a child under the age of 18 in your household, that child can receive free breakfast and free lunch through the end of this school year from our cafeteria. The State is paying for these meals. Please contact Mr. Mike Rossi for details at 860-376-2403. The front office secretary will transfer your call to him.

Student Pickup: End of Day

This is a reminder that PreK -4 pickup is from 2:50p.m. to 3:00p.m. at the track area. Grades 5-8 students are dismissed at 3:00p.m. out of the doors by the Senior Center. Please be sure to park in a designated spot. No one should be double parked at any point. If the lot is full, there is overflow parking at the rear of the Fire House, the Town Hall, and the Newent Congregational Church. Thank you for your help and understanding as we are handling a much larger amount of students for parent pickup than usual.

In-Person Instruction

Please know that most of our students are attending LCS in person, four days per week. They are doing a great job of following all of our protocols and mitigation strategies. Currently, approximately 15 % of our students have elected to opt into full remote learning. If your child is now engaged in full remote learning and you would like your child to attend in-person, four days per week, please notify the office three days in advance of the return date. Thank you.

Please be advised that teachers for students in grades 5-8 will be involved in a meeting from 11:30a.m. to 12:15p.m. in the LCS Media Center this coming Wednesday. They therefore will not be available to students for remote learning during this time. Thank you in advance for your understanding.
