Transportation Complaints

The Superintendent shall establish with the bus contractor a formal complaint procedure (form) which will provide the necessary information to study the complaint. After reviewing all information pertinent to the situation, the Superintendent will make a recommendation to the Lisbon Board of Education Transportation committee regarding the complaint.

The Lisbon Board of Education Transportation Committee will hear all complaints which are not settled at the administrative level and will report their recommendations to the Lisbon Board of Education. All written complaints will be forwarded to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, with a copy maintained at the Board of Education office, at the end of the school year.

Transportation Accident Reporting Procedures

1. ALL ACCIDENTS must be reported immediately to the transportation supervisor and to the school. An accident is any occurrence which involves possible injury or property damage. Anytime a company vehicle makes contact with another vehicle, a fixed object or another company vehicle, it must be reported. Failure to report an accident will result in disciplinary action.
2. Any injury to a driver, passenger or pedestrian on or near the bus during loading / unloading or the ride must be reported to the transportation supervisor and school officials. Injuries caused by the actions of others on the bus must be reported.
3. All necessary reports must be filled out immediately following an accident. All reports must be signed by the operator.
