Otherwise Lawful Possession of Firearms on School Property

The Lisbon Board of Education prohibits possession of firearms on school district property. The issuance of a permit to carry a pistol or revolver does not authorize the possession or carrying of a pistol or revolver on school property. The traversing of district property with an unloaded firearm for the purpose of gaining access to public or private lands open to hunting or for other lawful purposes is also prohibited by the Board of Education.

At the discretion of the Superintendent, **unloaded** firearms may be allowed on school property for historical or educational purposes. Approval must be given prior to firearms being transported onto school property.

The Board of Education may employ or enter into an agreement for public school security services with a firearm, as defined in state law, only with a sworn member of a local or state police department or a retired state or local police officer, or retired federal law enforcement agents and retired police officers from an out-of-state police department.

Students are prohibited by the Board of Education from possessing firearms for any reason, whether otherwise lawful or not, in or on the district property or on district transportation.
