Tuition Policy

Designated High School

The Lisbon Board of Education designates the Norwich Free Academy (NFA) and Griswold High School as the high schools which eligible students residing in Lisbon may attend. Students may also select and apply to other high school programs indicated below. First year high school students and students new to the district enrolling for the first time shall make that election with the understanding that they shall not be permitted to transfer after October 1 of the current school year.

The Board will pay the required tuition and provide transportation for eligible Lisbon students who attend the designated high schools or any of the following high schools:

- Norwich Regional Vocational/Technical School
- Ella T. Grasso Regional Vocational/Technical School
- Ledyard Vocational/Agricultural School

The Board will pay the required tuition for eligible Lisbon students who attend the following high schools. Transportation will be provided at the discretion of the district:

- Science and Technology Magnet School
- Capital Arts Magnet School
- Marine Science Magnet High School

The cost for education at State of Connecticut Vocational/Technical Schools is paid by the State of Connecticut.

Except as provided below, the Board of Education shall not be responsible for the tuition or transportation of any eligible Lisbon student who transfers out of one designated high school to another after October 1 unless granted late acceptance into a charter or magnet school. Any currently enrolled student wishing to transfer from one high school to another must notify the Lisbon School Superintendent of this possibility by February 1st of the preceding school year in order for tuition to be correctly budgeted. A letter regarding this policy will be sent annually as a reminder to all parents/guardians of District high school students. (See Attachment A)

Special education placements at any grade level at any high school may be approved by the Superintendent of Schools upon recommendations for a special education out-of-district placement by the Director of Special Education when necessary to meet a student's special educational needs identified through the special education process in the Lisbon Public Schools. Transfer requests due to exceptional circumstances will be granted at the discretion of the Superintendent of Schools.
