The National Junior Honor Society is an organization that recognizes and encourages academic achievement while developing other characteristics essential to democracy.

Members are selected for membership by a Faculty Council, which is made up of five faculty members.

Scholarship

A student who maintains a grade point average of 3.45 or higher in their sixth through eighth grade career

Leadership

A student who has demonstrated leadership in promoting school activities, upholds school ideals, exercises a positive influence on peers, has a positive attitude, inspires a positive attitude in others and is dependable.

Character

A student who takes criticism willingly, upholds principles of morality and ethics, complies with school regulations concerning property, halls, cafeteria, etc., observes rules and is truthful.

Citizenship

A student who understands the importance of civic involvement, has a high regard for freedom, justice, and a respect for the American form of government.

Service

A student who volunteers, is dependable and well-organized, works well with others and shows courtesy by assisting visitors, teachers, and students.

Members are expected to continue to demonstrate the qualities of:

Leadership

Character

Citizenship

Service

Students not continuing to meet standards will be warned orally, then in writing before being dismissed. However, in the event of a flagrant violation of school or civic law, a warning is not necessary.

A student who is dismissed or who resigns may never again be a National Junior Honor Society Member.

Membership

- 1. N.J.H.S. is open to all qualifying 7th and 8th grade students. All academically eligible 7th grade students will receive applications after the 3rd marking period. All academically eligible 8th grade students will receive applications after the 2nd marking period.
- 2. There is no limitation to the number of members per class.
- 3. Students being considered for membership must have been in attendance a minimum of one full semester at Lisbon Central School.
- 4. Membership from another school is transferable.
- 5. Members are not selected by grades alone.
- 6. Students with poor disciplinary records will not be considered for membership.
- 7. Students considered for membership shall have demonstrated character, service, citizenship, and leadership abilities.
