

Unvaccinated CLOSE CONTACT TO A COVID POSITIVE PERSON

Close Contact is **UNVACCINATED** and has **NO** symptoms



A 10 day quarantine from the date of last exposure is recommended. (Day of exposure = Day 0) Monitor for symptoms until Day 14 and wear a mask in public. Test if person starts to have symptoms.



If test result is **NEGATIVE**:
Continue with a 10 day quarantine. Monitor for symptoms until Day 14 and wear a mask in public. If you develop symptoms, begin isolation for 10 days from start of symptoms.

If test result is **POSITIVE**:
Begin isolation. Isolation period is 10 days from date of exposure, or the date of the test collection if you do not know the date you were exposed. When isolation period is complete, you may return to work/school **if your symptoms are improving**. Continue to monitor for symptoms from Day 11-14 and wear a mask in public.

Close Contact is **UNVACCINATED** and has symptoms



Begin isolation. Test as soon as possible.



If test result is **NEGATIVE**:
Continue to isolate. Isolation period is 10 days from date your symptoms began or the date you were tested, whichever came first. When isolation period is complete, you may return to work/school if you do not have symptoms for 24 hours. Continue to monitor for symptoms from Day 11-14 and wear a mask in public.

If your test result is **POSITIVE**:
Continue to isolate. Isolation period is 10 days from date your symptoms began or the date you were tested, whichever came first. When isolation period is complete, you may return to work/school if you do not have a fever for 24 hours of last day and overall, your symptoms are improving. Continue to monitor for symptoms from Day 11-14 and wear a mask in public.

DEFINITION of a CLOSE CONTACT: A person who has spent at least 15 minutes (within 24 hours) within 6 feet of a person diagnosed with COVID-19, starting 48 hours before the person became ill and/or tested positive, and regardless of masks. For students in a classroom setting, close contact is spending 15 minutes (within 24 hours) within 3 feet of an infected person if wearing masks.

ANTIGEN (rapid) and PCR COVID TEST RESULTS: a negative antigen test in a person with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or a close contact without symptoms should be followed up with a PCR test.
