Technology

We have had questions from a few parents regarding the status of technology instruction and learning at LCS. Please know that the learning of computer skills is not isolated to the Computer Lab. Students are utilizing their chromebooks in the classroom, Library and Computer Lab, to look up information and to practice typing and content area skills. Different applications utilized are: Moby Max, Google Suite, Typing Club, etc.

In terms of the Computer Lab, students in grades 3-8 will continue to work on Moby Max Math for 45 minutes per week for the remainder of Trimester 1 and all of Trimester 2. In Trimester 3, these students will work on computer skills, projects, and/or applications for 45 minutes.

Students in grades K-2 will continue to work in the Computer Lab on learning computer skills for the remainder of Trimester 1. During Trimester 2 and Trimester 3, students will work on Moby Max for 20 minutes and continue to work on computer skills, and/or applications for 25 minutes.

Additionally, all students will continue to practice their typing skills at the end of their library time. If you have any questions, please contact LCS Administration. Again, we hope that this clarifies any issues/ concerns.
