In the State of Connecticut, the School Meals Assistance Revenue for Transition (SMART) funds has been enacted allowing all students to temporarily receive free breakfast and lunch meals regardless of family income. Lisbon's allocation will provide funding for free meals through Friday December 16, 2022. **On Monday December 19, 2022 the district will revert to charging for meals.** This is a revision to a memo from November 17, 2022.

FREE AND REDUCED PRICE MEAL APPLICATION INFORMATION: We encourage families who are in need of financial assistance (and who have not done so already), to complete and submit the confidential Free and Reduced Price Meal Application (on the schools website) to ensure meal benefits are available for students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals.

Parents or guardians can submit this application in person to Colleen McNally-Reamer. The application includes detailed instructions on how to complete and submit to the Food Service Department. Applications can be submitted at any point in the school year as household income may change during the year.

There are 3 ways to make payments for your student's account

1. Checks made payable to Lisbon Hot Lunch – include students first and last name and account #.
2. Payschoolscentral.com – please refer to the website to enroll your student.
3. Cash – Please send in the amount to be placed on your student's account.
