Parent morning drop-off information

We would like to remind parents of our morning drop-off procedure and make everyone aware of an upcoming change. Parent drop-off is in the back of the building, by the Lisbon Senior Center. There is a staff member to greet students at the drop-off daily. Parents may drop off their child/children beginning at 8:00 am. Students proceed to the cafeteria. Free breakfast is available to students. School begins at 8:15 am. Beginning Monday, April 17, 2023, staff will remain in the back of the building **until 8:20 am**. After 8:20 am, students will need to be dropped off in front of the building and enter the building at the main entrance. After 8:20 pm, students will be considered late and will need to check in at the office.
