Board of Education 2023-2024 Budget

We would like our LCS parents and friends to know that at this point in time, the Town's Board of Finance is sending the 2023-2024 Board of Education Budget to the Annual Town Hearing scheduled for May 1st at 7:00 p.m. in the LCS cafeteria. This budget has an increase of 4.97% over this year's budget. It is a fiscally sound budget that addresses the needs of our students, staff, and building. This hearing is open to the public; we hope to see you there.

Gerald Ducharme Project - IDEAS DUE BY APRIL 23, 2023

The Lisbon school community is the fortunate recipient of a monetary gift of about \$100,000 from a community member, Gerald Ducharme, intended to benefit the Lisbon School.
