## Student Dress Code Reminder

As the warmer weather approaches, we would like to remind our families that all students' garments must be in compliance with the dress code for the duration of the school day. The standards for the appropriate dress are listed below. This information can also be found in [Dress Code Policy #5132](#).

### Pants

- Jeans, dress, cargo, and athletic styles
- Pants cannot hang below the waist
- Official LCS flannel pants will be accepted

### Shorts

- Jeans, dress, cargo, and athletic styles
- Must not be shorter than mid-thigh length and cannot hang below the waist.

### Dresses and Skirts

- Must not be shorter than a hand width above the knee.
- Dresses must completely cover shoulders and not expose cleavage.

### Leggings

- Leggings may be worn only along with shorts, dresses, and skirts of appropriate length or with shirts that extend to mid-thigh length.

### Footwear

- Footwear must be worn at all times.
- Shoes, sandals, flats, boots, flip-flops, and sneakers
- Sneakers must be worn for participation in gym class

### Shirts, Blouses, Tops

- Collared shirts — any color and/or pattern
- T-shirts
- Knit tops and blouses — any color and/or pattern
- All tops must completely cover shoulders and not expose any cleavage or midriff.

### Sweaters, Hoodies, and Sweatshirts

- Crew neck sweaters, V-neck sweaters, pullover sweatshirts/hoodies, and zip-up sweatshirts/hoodies

### Outerwear

- Jackets, coats, blazers, suit jackets, and vests

### Head Coverings

- All students must remove head coverings upon entering the school building (with exceptions as listed above).
