Classroom assignments

Morning Drop-off and Afternoon Pick-up

We would like our families to know that we have established new procedures for parents dropping off their student(s) in the morning and for parents picking up their student(s) in the afternoon. Thank you to Tom Sparkman, Trooper Adams, and Brian McGlew for their help with this new procedure. Both drop-off and pick-up will continue to be in the Lisbon Senior Center behind LCS. However, we will be having families enter through the entrance by the Lisbon Fire Station and exit through the driveway between the Lisbon Senior Center and LCS. Any drop-off in front of the Lisbon Senior Center or at the LCS maintenance doors is no longer allowed. All traffic needs to follow this new flow pattern. Families are to remain in their vehicles at all times and follow the drop-off/pick-up procedure. Both drop-off and pick-up will be at the LCS stairs located at the back of the building by the Lisbon Senior Center. These procedures will be sent to families in a separate email next week. Following these procedures and keeping a patient and positive demeanor means we are all doing our part to keep our students safe and our routines as efficient as possible. Bus transportation is available for all students.
