 - d) Johnny Bees has a food truck and may provide food off a menu for the Mom Prom. Will see if we can get a menu, would be an extra expense for people ordering. Would still be able to bring in our own snacks.
 - e) Decorations, linens discussed for tables. \$70 for tablecloths. Balloon arch discussed. Nothing can be hung from the walls. Will possibly have a photo booth with built in program to use for the Mom Prom. Centerpieces discussed.
 - f) Prizes for best promposal and a door prize. Discussed possibility of a basket raffle. Talked about the door prize being a gift card for Johnny Bees for \$25. Budget for best promposal prize set at \$50. PTO executive members will provide gift baskets for the raffle.
 - g) Koozie's discussed as favors, \$100 budgeted.
 - h) Everly After Floral to partner with us to make corsages with a percentage coming back to PTO
