4th Grade: Russian Nesting Dolls

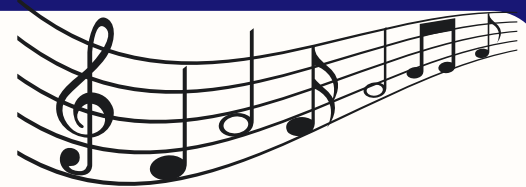
5th Grade: Printmaking
