Budget Update

Please know that Board Chairman Ian Rogers, Superintendent Sally Keating and Business Manager Jonathan Paradis have presented the 2025-2026 Board of Education Budget to the Town's Board of Finance at an 8.77% increase. Most of this increase is due to special education costs, health insurance, contractual requirements and school tuitions. These are non-negotiable items. The primary goal of this budget is to maintain staffing. Thus far, there have been very minimal reductions of hours of a few staff members. Next Wednesday evening, March 26, 2025, there is a Town Board of Finance Meeting at 7:00p.m. at the Lisbon Town Hall. At this meeting, there will be an update of the status of the Board of Education Budget. This is a public meeting.
