## From the Nurse's Office

- **End-of-Year Reminder**

All medications in the Nurse's office (including inhalers and EpiPens) must be picked up by a parent by the end of the school day on Thursday, June 18<sup>th</sup>. Anything remaining will be discarded.

- **Medication Health Forms**

If you would like your child to receive any medications during the 2026/2027 school year (including Ibuprofen or Acetaminophen), please be sure your doctor fills out the [Administration of Medication Form](#). If this form is not on file in the Nurse's office, your child will not be given medication at school. All medication must be brought to school by a parent/guardian. DO NOT send any medication to school with your child, prescription or nonprescription. Please be sure to turn in the new forms as soon as possible.

- **Sunscreen**

We kindly ask that parents apply sunscreen to their child in the morning before coming to school. Students are not allowed to carry or apply sunscreen on their own unless the signed permission form is completed and turned in to the nurse. - **Physicals & Immunizations**

All students enrolling in Pre-K, Kindergarten, or 7th grade must present a physical dated within one calendar year before the first day of school and complete an immunization record before they can begin.
